Completed Candidate Forms must be turned in to the NJHS Adviser in Room 294 by Friday, March 14, 2020. Forms may not be turned in to the SSMS Front Office staff, or to any other teacher. No late applications will be accepted.

The Faculty Council will review all Candidate Forms that are submitted by the required deadline in order to determine selection or non-selection for membership. During this process, the Faculty Council will review the copy of the report card for Scholarship (GPA) eligibility, teacher evaluation input, and the responses on the Candidate Form to evaluate each candidate in the areas of Leadership, Service, Citizenship, and Character.

Then, the NJHS Advisers and Principal will review and approve the decisions. After all selection and non-selection decisions have been approved, the NJHS Faculty Council will notify all candidates of their selection or non-selection in writing. The date for this notification is currently planned for Friday, March 27, 2020.

Selected candidates will be inducted at the official NJHS Induction Ceremony, which will take place at on Thursday, April 2, 2020.

This chapter is governed in all matters by the rules, regulations, and Constitution of the National Junior Honor Society. Candidates will be selected by a review and majority vote by the Faculty Council, based upon the requirements of that council in accordance with the NJHS Constitution. "Membership in this chapter is an honor bestowed upon deserving students by the faculty and shall be based on the criteria of Scholarship, Service, Leadership, Citizenship, and Character" (NJHS Handbook, 13th Edition, page 26).
