and I, the undersigned, understand that my child, if transported by a privately owned vehicle, charter bus, school bus or walking, hereby release the District School Board of Pasco County, the individual members of said Board, the Superintendent, the principal, teachers or other employees of the school, and volunteer leaders from any financial responsibility because of sickness of the student while going to, returning from, or attending said field trip or because of any accident in which the student is injured. To ensure prompt attention in case of sickness or accident, I hereby authorize the person(s) in charge of said trip to incur expense considered necessary for treatment, and I agree to pay for same if this is in excess of the amount paid by any accident or health insurance policy that may be in effect at the time of the sickness or accident.

In any situation in which the safety and security of students might be compromised (e.g., Red Alert Status issued by the Department of Homeland Security, severe weather conditions, etc.) the District School Board of Pasco County will take the necessary steps to ensure the safety of its students and staff, including the cancellation of scheduled field trips and school events. Should this trip or event be cancelled as a result of such an event, the District cannot guarantee any monies (including deposits) will be refunded by the vendor(s) associated with this transaction. Therefore, students, parents, guardians, etc., are hereby cautioned and advised that the District will not be liable for any reimbursements associated with this event that are not refunded by the vendor(s) and returned to the District.

Transportation: We will be taking charter busses. Please be at SSMS bus loop off Photonics right at 5:30 pm to pick up your student. **Please do not park on the curb so the busses have a place to drop off students. No students may be picked up at the theme park.**

Tickets: 300 spaces are available and will be on a first come first serve basis. The final deadline for payments will be Friday, February 10. **A SPOT IS SECURED BY RETURNED PERMISSION SLIP (DOUBLE SIDED) THAT IS ATTACHED TO THIS DOCUMENT.**

Group Sign Up: Students will be in groups of 10 with one chaperone for the entire time we are at Busch Gardens. Students may choose their own groups. Sign up will be on Monday, Feb 13 in the cafeteria starting in the morning (8:10 am) and resuming at lunch.

Eligibility: In order to be eligible students must have no referrals on or after **Monday, December 5**, that result in ISS or OSS. Students must meet individual class, team and administrative guidelines to be eligible to attend an activity or event. For safety reasons, we may choose to deny attendance to students who have exhibited poor or questionable behavior at any time prior to the trip. **REFUNDS WILL ONLY BE CONSIDERED IN EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES AND UNDER ADMINISTRATIVE APPROVAL.**

Dress Code: All students will be required to follow the school and Busch Gardens dress code. Students are required to wear their official unaltered t-shirt for the duration of the event. Long sleeve under shirts are permitted. Students not wearing their official t-shirt will not be allowed on the bus or to attend trip. Drawstring backpacks or small purses no bigger than 8x12 are permitted along with hats and sunglasses.

Code of Conduct: The Pasco County Code of Student Conduct is in effect at all school related events. Any student choosing to violate the Student Code of Conduct, either by association or by committing the act personally, will receive any or all of the interventions prescribed by the District School Board of Pasco County.
